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Acceptable Use Agreement for KS2 (Students and Parents)

We have a lots of ways to keep you safe online. To make you even safer we would like you to follow these rules whenever you use the computers and Internet. Please tick each rule to show that you understand it.

I will be SMART...

- I will keep my username and password safe and secure. I will not share it or write it down. I will not try to use anyone else's username and password.
- I will not share personal information about myself or others when online (e.g. full name, address, email address, telephone numbers, age, school).
- I will never arrange to meet people in real life that I have only spoken to online. I will remember that people online might not always be who they say they are.
- When I am using the Internet to find information, I will take care to check that the information that I use is correct as I know that some things on the Internet are not true.
- I will tell an adult or report anything I see online that is inappropriate or that makes me feel uncomfortable.

I will also follow these online safety rules...

- I will be polite and responsible when I communicate with others online.
- I will not take or share pictures/videos of anyone without their permission.
- I will not bring in my own personal devices (mobiles/tablets) to school unless my parents get permission from the school.
- I will look after the computing equipment in school and understand that there will be a consequence if anything is deliberately damaged or broken.
- I will not try to install any programmes, download anything off the Internet or change the computer settings.
- I will not use any social media site in school.
- I will only use suitable, age-appropriate websites in school.

Now you know the rules, please read these and tick them to show you understand what they mean.

- I understand that my school can look at what I access on the Internet in school.
- I understand that if I break these online safety rules then there will be consequences: my parents/carers could be told, I could not be allowed on the computer/Internet, I may lose privileges in school or, if it was illegal, the police would be involved.
- I understand that there will also be consequences if I am involved in incidents of inappropriate online behaviour that involve my school or someone from my school when I am at home (e.g. cyber-bullying, sharing pictures/videos without permission)
